



Non-Identifying Information

Thank you for your request for Non-Identifying Information. This is a basic report of non-identifying information in the file (no names, addresses, phone numbers). The report is generally about birthparents and the birth process, but it may contain social history, physical descriptions and some genetic/medical background.

Non-Identifying Information is available to those persons age 18 and over, provided that person is one of the following:

- * An adult adoptee
- * A birth parent
- * An adoptive parent or guardian of an adoptee

In the event of the death of an adoptee, the following persons age 18 and over may receive Non-Identifying Information:

- * A child or descendent of an adoptee
- * An adoptee's spouse, if that spouse is also a birth parent to the adoptee's child
- * A guardian of an adoptee's child

If you are one of the above-named and you wish to request non-identifying information, you must:

- * Complete the enclosed form
- * Enclose a copy of your birth certificate*
- * Enclose a check or money order payable to Boys & Girls Aid in the amount of \$100.00

Return the form, birth certificate and payment to - Boys & Girls Aid - M/S #27 - PO Box 5700 - Portland, OR 97228-5700. After we receive your form and payment, it may take several weeks for this information to be processed and sent back to you. We appreciate your patience.

* If you do not have a copy of your birth certificate, and were born in Oregon, you can obtain a copy of your birth certificate from: Oregon Vital Records - 800 NE Oregon St, Suite #205 - Portland, OR 97232. Phone: (971) 673-1190. There is a \$20 fee for the copy. *Note: If you are 21 and were born in Oregon you can also obtain a copy of your pre-adoptive/original birth certificate through Oregon Vital Records. For purposes of the Adoption Registry we require a copy of your birth certificate showing your adoptive name along with the names of your adoptive parents.*
